In compliance with the Memorandum dated 27, March 2020 issued by the Mines and Geosciences Bureau Re Realignment of Social Development and Management Programs unutilized funds to support affected impact and non- impact communities due to COVID-19 and Memorandum from the Executive Secretary dated March 31, 2020 requiring the submission of the Report to Congress pursuant to RA No. 11469, the Mining Companies in CARAGA Region assist and support both the community residents and frontliners in partnership with the Local Government Unit (Barangay, Municipality, Province) against COVID 19 virus.

For this reporting period, a total of 12 mining companies provided goods and other means of support to help sustain the day to day needs of the community and the frontliners. A total of **PhP 15,895,075.50** was expended for this reporting period. The revised total budget allocation is already placed at **PhP 83,382,331.33**.

### Issues Encountered

The issues encountered of some mining companies in delivering its assistance and services to the communities and front liners, are the following:

- Scarcity of suppliers of rice and canned goods and the supplies of vitamins and disinfectants;
- Delayed arrival of the PPEs and medical apparatus as local supplies in the region are no longer available and items will have to be shipped out somewhere. The transportation and mobilization of goods was also delayed due to several checkpoints in several boundaries between provinces;
- Limited manpower to process the procurement because the company is on skeletal force and the schedule of release in the barangays were not synchronized due to lack of manpower as measure on the enhanced quarantine and some barangays opt not to release until they exhaust available stocks from other sources; and
- Distribution of relief to IP families in the hinterlands needs clearance from the military and assistance to secure the area from leftist groups prior to entry of ComRel personnel.
