For this reporting period, a total of 12 mining companies provided goods and other means of support to help sustain the day to day needs of the community and the frontliners. A total of **PhP 4,845,147.72** was expended for this reporting period, thus bringing the total amount spent thus far since the Apri 8 reporting period to **PhP 63,890,971.12**. The revised total budget allocation is already placed at **PhP 96,684,063.13**.

# Issues Encountered

The following are the same issues encountered by some mining companies from the start of their assistance in delivering services to the communities and front liners:

- Scarcity of supplies.
- Delayed arrival of the PPEs and medical apparatus. The transportation and mobilization of goods was also delayed due to several checkpoints in several boundaries.
- Double handling in transporting food packs to the coastal areas using pump boats.
- Limited manpower to process the procurement because the company is on skeletal force and the schedule of release in the barangays were not synchronized due to lack of manpower as measure on the enhanced quarantine; and
- Clearance from the military and assistance to secure the area is still needed for the safe distribution of relief goods to the indigenous people (IP) communities, but still assistance was securely turned over to IP.
